- Scheduled to return on a quarterly basis. The next presentation is set for the month of October, the date to be determined.

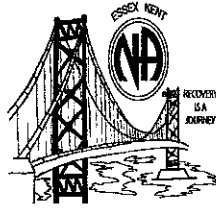
July 26th, 2018. World hepatitis day

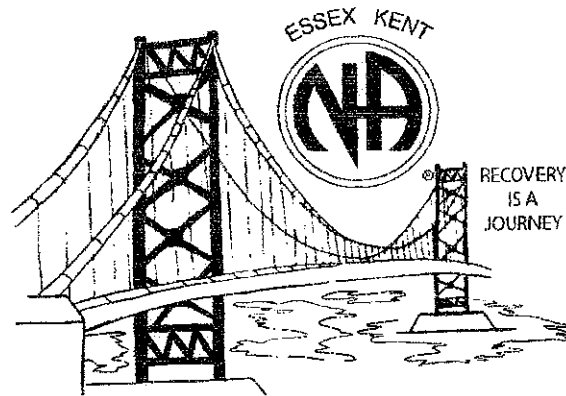
